

From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Church Family,

People are sometimes offended by the judgment one makes. Especially when it is a judgment that renders a decision that some feel is wrong or makes them uncomfortable.

Moral judgments have come under fire in this day and age. If Christians make a moral judgment about societal immorality we often hear that we should not be judgmental towards other lest WE are judged by the same measure.

The fact is that no one is guiltless from judging others nor did Jesus ever forbid us from making sound judgment against another based on Biblical teaching.

John the Baptist called it as HE SAW IT an adulterous relationship between Herod and Herodias who was his brother's wife (Luke 3:19-20).

Jesus called it as HE SAW IT when he called the Pharisees & Scribes serpents, broods of vipers & hypocrites (Matthew 23:23-36).

Paul called it as HE SAW IT when he called the young man out for having sex with his father's wife (1 Corinthians 5).
